Dear Parents, Faculty and Friends of C.I.C:

Win Sargent, who has been Superintendent at C.I.C for the past 12 years, is retiring at the end of the school year. Win is a fixture at our school and the school clearly reflects his personality and dedication. He has seen us through political upheavals, attempted coups, a general strike and a troubling exodus of our families both foreign and local. Throughout this period, Win has led the school in providing an excellent education for your children – equipping them to contribute to the complex world to which they are entering. In addition, he has led the school community in providing new facilities and challenged the faculty and staff to improve the education we offer our students.

As a lasting testament to Win and his contribution to our school, we wish to create a scholarship in his name to be awarded to a private paying student who can demonstrate financial need and is already enrolled at C.I.C. in grades 6 through 12. This student must be an excellent citizen of the school and actively involved in Fine Arts and AyA.

Members of the CIC School Board have personally pledged a minimum of \$10,000 to this fund and hope to raise another \$20,000 from the greater CIC community. The Board has agreed that whatever is raised from its own contributions and through our appeal will be further matched by school funds in hopes of reaching our goal of a minimum of \$60,000. This endowment fund would provide up to \$3000 per year for a student in need. We are asking for your help now so that we can reach this goal.

When you sit down with your checkbook to make a valued contribution to this worthy scholarship, think about the teacher who made the most constructive difference in your life, as Win has made in the lives of so many of the students he has led on the path to learning and success.
